

# Ironbark Brewery

Get Down Under at the Ironbark Brewer for some wholesome Australian tucker and a selection of award-winning beers invented by a pioneering wheat farmer who has become a local brew-master.

It's really no surprise that Ironbark Brewery director and chief brewer Graeme White was once a wheat farmer. Tune into his broad Australian accent and learn about his love of beer, and there you have the archetypal Aussie.

Dig a little deeper and you'll discover Graeme has a deep understanding of the micro-brewing process and a penchant for experimentation, including the production of cherry and lime ales and ginger beer.

Graeme and his family began making Pilsner and wheat ales at his purpose-built 1500-litre brewery in Caversham four years ago. A short time later and his renowned cherry ale, rare in WA but a popular drink in Belgium, was creating a west coast sensation.

Graeme adapted the Belgian style beer, refining the sweet-tart taste to impress judges at the annual Royal Melbourne Show where he won a silver medal. Graeme's Iron Bock beer received the same accolade.

Other must-try refreshment includes Graeme's German-style dark malt beer, another favourite with locals together with the 'Tinny Thomas' ginger beer. There is simply no place better to go for a pint and a chat with at least eight handcrafted, boutique beers on tap every day.

Brew-master Graeme is currently experimenting with a seven percent alcohol-content beer, which he has dubbed The Debilitator with a low-alcohol counterpart entitled The Rehabilitator.

While beer is the focus of the establishment, the brewery also serves a selection of Australian-style foods, from the Mallee Bull scotch-fillet steak to the Boundary Rider kangaroo burger, the Stockman's baguettes and a smoked chicken salad prepared by chef Les Howard.

On a fine day, the outdoor pizza oven and a spit-roast can swing into action and are popular for private functions.

Every day's a g'day at the Ironbark so pull up your 44-gallon drum cafe-style table and get out there and enjoy the great outdoors.
